

**Violin Sizing Guide\* - Have your student hold out their left arm as if playing a violin and measure from the neck to the wrist where it meets the hand**

<b>Arm Length (in)</b>	<b>Violin Size</b>
19" – 21"	1/2 size Violin
22" – 23"	3/4 size Violin
24" and longer	4/4 (full) size Violin

**Viola Sizing Guide\* - Have your student hold out their left arm as if playing a viola and measure from the neck to the wrist where it meets the hand**

<b>Arm Length (in)</b>	<b>Viola Size</b>
19" – 21"	12" Viola
22" – 23"	13" Viola
24" and longer	14" Viola

**Cello Sizing Guide\* - Measure by your students height**

<b>Height (ft)</b>	<b>Cello Size</b>
4' – 4.5'	1/2 size Cello
4.5' – 5'	3/4 size Cello
5' and taller	4/4 (full) size Cello

**Bass Sizing Guide\* - Based on height**

<b>Height</b>	<b>Bass Size</b>
5 <sup>th</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> grade students of average height	1/4 size bass
6 <sup>th</sup> grade students of above average height	1/2 size bass
